

RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS/EMPLOYEES ACCESS TO THE SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX OF THE CITY OF ELKINS

WHEREAS, the City of Elkins maintains a safety deposit box at Chambers Bank on Center Street in Elkins.

WHEREAS, from time to time various City officials or employees need to access such box for purposes of placing something inside for safekeeping or taking something out for official city business.

WHEREAS, safekeeping of computer backup disks and records is a primary use of this safety deposit box and each person utilizing it has need for access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELKINS, ARKANSAS, that:

SECTION 1: Any one of the following five (5) officials/employees of the City of Elkins may and hereby are authorized to have access to the safety deposit box (#225) of the City of Elkins maintained at Chambers Bank on Hwy. 16 in Elkins, AR, to-wit:


Elkins District Court Clerk – Rene' Allen


