

## RESOLUTION 2013-10

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2012-34 OF THE CITY OF ELKINS, ARKANSAS; AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2013, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2013.

WHEREAS, the City Council has been confronted with unexpected and unanticipated billing in excess of the amount budgeted in Resolution 2012-34, and income different than anticipated for 2013; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that an Amendment to the budget adopted by Resolution 2012-34, is required to make appropriations of the revenue to cover the additional expenses for the year 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ELKINS, ARKANSAS:


Section 1: That Resolution 2012-34 which adopted the Budget for the City of Elkins, for the year 2013 which reflected estimates of revenues and expenditures, does not adequately meet the needs of the City of Elkins at the present time, Exhibit. "A" attached hereto reflects the budget contained in Resolution 2012-34 and the highlighted portions reflect all changes necessary to enable the City of Elkins to adequately meet its expenditures and appropriation needs to conduct business for 2013.

Section 2: The highlighted amounts in Exhibit "A", reflect the changes made in each line of the budget as attached to Resolution 2012-34.


Section 3: Whereas, it is necessary for the efficient operation of municipal government that the budget approved by Resolution 2012-34 be amended to allow for the effective running of the City of Elkins. That Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted by the City Council

of Elkins, Arkansas, as an Amendment to the Budget adopted by Resolution 2012-34, to cover the period January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.
